Letter from Delhi to Mantralaya to transform KDMC Rukminibai Hospital



Success to the efforts of MNS city organizer Rupesh Bhoir

Kalyan:

MNS Kalyan city organizer Rupesh Chandrakant Bhoir had sent a letter to the Union Health Minister to get the status of government hospital for Bai Rukminibai Hospital of Kalyan Dombivli Municipal Corporation. The Center has now taken note of last month's correspondence and directed the Chief Secretary of the Maharashtra Health Department to consider the matter.

Bai Rukminibai Hospital is important for the health of the citizens of Kalyan city as well as the neighboring villages. It is also a shelter for the poor. But due to lack of facilities, people are not able to avail adequate health care. Sometimes due to shortage of doctors and sometimes due to other reasons, citizens have to move to another city. Due to lack of modern equipment in this hospital, the number of patients in Mumbai and Thane hospitals is increasing. Rupesh Bhoir said that if Bai Rukminibai Hospital gets the status of a government hospital, it will help in making state-of-the-art equipment available and will stop the flow of people from Kalyan Dombivli to other cities for medical treatment. I wrote a letter to the Union Health Minister along with Maharashtra Health Minister Rajesh Tope on the issue of health of the citizens. No reply has been received from the Maharashtra Health Minister yet. However, a letter has been received from the Center and it has been mentioned that the letter has been submitted to the Chief Secretary of the Health Department for further action. Rupesh Bhoir said that the MNS will now follow up for the government hospital and in any case, Bai Rukminibai Hospital will get the status of a government hospital.

Cops at sealed buildings, marshals to ensure masks in Mumbai as Covid cases rise

Mumbai :

Mumbai civic commissioner Iqbal Singh Chahal has directed officials to deploy police at the entrance of buildings sealed in order to stop people from entering them in another attempt to curb the spread of Covid-19 cases, which have been on the rise in the city. A building is sealed in Mumbai if it has five or more Covid-19 patients, according to the current civic protocol. Chahal said on Monday people living in such buildings in Mumbai might be inconvenienced by the order but asked them to cooperate so that the pandemic could be controlled.

"Given our previous experience in this regard, we need to be very vigilant about the implementation of Covid preventive measures. In this connection, as per the rules already enforced, the building in which more than 5 Covid-19 infected patients are found is sealed, must be followed," Chahal was quoted as saying by news agency ANI. "Precautionary measures must be taken very strictly considering the possibility of a third wave and to prevent the spread of Covid-19 to others," he added.



The Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) said in a release that no one would be allowed to enter these sealed buildings and people who come to provide various services would also be stopped. The city had 27 sealed buildings as of Monday. The BMC said the number of Covid-19 patients has gone up slightly in Mumbai and that there was a need to be vigilant about implementing preventive measures against the disease. The decision was taken at a

virtual meeting chaired by Chahal and attended by ward officers, hospital deans and officials of the civic public health department as well as the Mumbai police's deputy commissioner (operations), the BMC release said. Chahal also told authorities in all the 24 wards of the BMC to appoint marshals to take punitive action against those not wearing masks or defying social distancing norms. He said 74 per cent of people above the age of 18 in Mumbai had been vaccinated against Covid-19 and

asked civic officials to ensure the rest 26 per cent are covered quickly. Data shows that Covid-19 cases in the Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR) have seen a slight surge in the past 15 days. It also showed that the daily average of 250 new cases registered in mid-August rose to 350 in the last five days. Mumbai recorded around 325 Covid-19 cases on August 1, which dropped to 262 on August 15 but reached 345 on August 29, according to the state health department.

Last hurdle for Uran local trains finally cleared

Navi Mumbai :

Maharashtra's most delayed project, the CSMT-Uran railway line, cleared the final environmental hurdle of forest land handover on Saturday. The Railways have now got the "all green" to proceed with the engineering work. In February 2021 how the Belapur-Seawoods Uran suburban railway project, being implemented jointly by Central Railway and the City Industrial Development Corporation Limited (CIDCO),

had been categorised as the most delayed railway project in Maharashtra with a time run-over of 216 months, which is 18 years," as per the union government's infrastructure and project monitoring division of the ministry of statistics and programme implementation. A 27-km long stretch Of the 27-km stretch, about 12-km stretch till Kharkopar is ready and operational with suburban trains. The remaining 15-km stretch work is part of phase 2 till Uran. The clearance



received on Saturday means that all permissions are now in, and the railways can proceed with the work. The line to Uran will be Central Railway's fourth corridor on the Mumbai suburban railway and will facilitate Mumbai CSMT-Uran local trains, also offering connectivity to the proposed

Navi Mumbai airport and the Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust, one of the country's largest shipping ports. **Total Length: 26.7 km Phase-I from Nerul/Belapur to Kharkopar: 12.4 km (complete) Phase-II from Kharkopar to Uran: 14.3 km (under works)**

Civic Official Loses 3 Fingers After Angry Hawker Attacks Her Near Mumbai



Thane :

The Thane civic body's drive against illegal hawkers took a grisly turn on Monday when a man, furious over the action being taken, attacked a senior official with a knife, chopping off three digits of her hand. Thane Assistant Municipal Commissioner Kalpita Pimple was attacked by vegetable vendor Amarjit Yadav while she

was overseeing a drive to clear out unauthorised hawkers in the Kasarvadavali locality. Ms Pimple was admitted to the Jupiter Hospital a short distance away. An attempt will be made to re-attach the severed digits to her hand, officials have said. Her condition was stable following hospitalisation, they said. Yadav was arrested and a probe has been launched over the incident.

Visuals from the spot immediately after the incident showed Yadav shouting in protest and carrying two knives even as the police officials try to convince him to surrender. He is also seen placing one knife on his own neck, although it was not clear from the video if he was threatening suicide. The police are now looking into the hawker's record for criminal antecedents

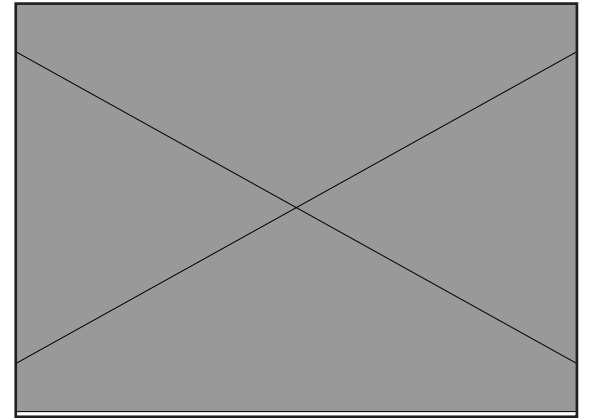
